## Applying to the Major

Applications are available on Banner and are accepted in the fall, winter, and spring. Students who wish to apply must meet all requirements and deadlines to be considered.

Students are eligible to apply up to the Accounting, Business Administration, and/or Economics majors up to three times.

### Admission Criteria:

- At least Sophomore standing (45+ credits)
- 2.5 cumulative GPA and 2.5 major GPA (or 3.0 cumulative GPA only)
- 15 credits completed in SBGE at SPU (10 credits for running start or transfer students)
- Complete and submit an application by the deadline(s)

## Economics Electives & Concentration Options

In addition to the General Economics Core and additional competencies and requirements, students must complete 15 credits of Upper Division electives in SBGE. Students who wish to pursue a concentration may complete the following discipline-specific coursework:
